PROFESSION OF FAITH

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. Music Notes

The Second Sunday of Easter is called by many other names: Divine Mercy Sunday, Sunday in the Octave of Easter, Quasi modo Sunday, and Dominica in Albis. The term Dominica in Albis was chosen when the newly baptized, the neophytes, would put on their white garments (albis) and come to Mass. Quasi modo Sunday is named after the introit of the day (much like Gaudete Sunday in Advent and Laetare Sunday in Lent). The Sunday in the Octave of Easter concludes the octave (8 days), which is a period of special celebration. During this week, the sequence "Victimae paschali" may be sung. Divine Mercy Sunday has been celebrated since 2000 as a special reminder of penance and God's mercy and redemption. A special Chaplet of the Divine Mercy may be prayed today or on any Friday.

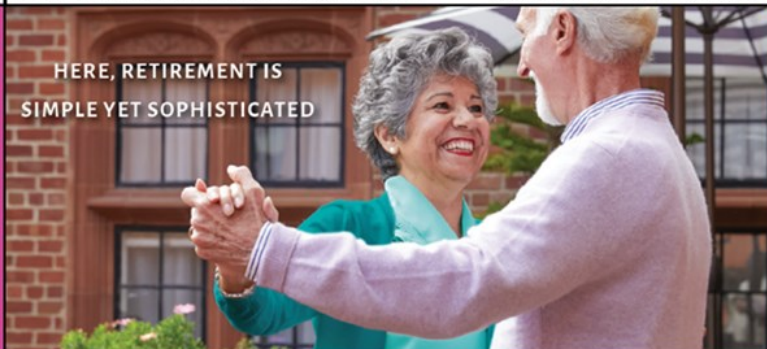
