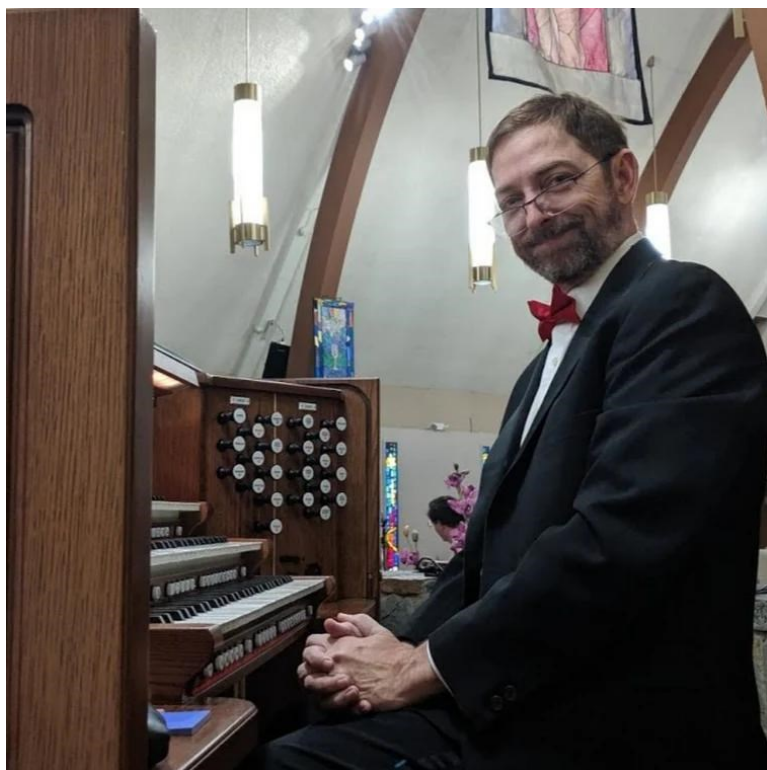

David Brock maintains an active organ recital schedule throughout the United States. Recent appearances have included Washington National Cathedral; the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels, Los Angeles; National City Christian Church, Washington, DC; First Lutheran Church, Venice, California; and the Virginia Theological Seminary Chapel, Alexandria, VA. Annually since 1999, each August David produces a series of organ recitals in Northern Nevada – Hot August Pipes – which has brought concert organ literature to the region.



David Brock is the Organist and Continuo artist with TOCCATA, the Tahoe Symphony Orchestra and Chorus, and has served in that role since the orchestra's founding in 2005. David has also made guest appearances with the Alexandria Symphony Orchestra in Virginia in performances of the Saint-Saens Organ Symphony and the Mozart Requiem.

David is Organist/Accompanist at St. John's Presbyterian Church, Reno, Nevada, which position he has held since 2019. In March 2020, Saint John's began offering online worship each Sunday at 10:30 am to serve both the local community and guests who are unable to attend live worship, due to either distance or health.
