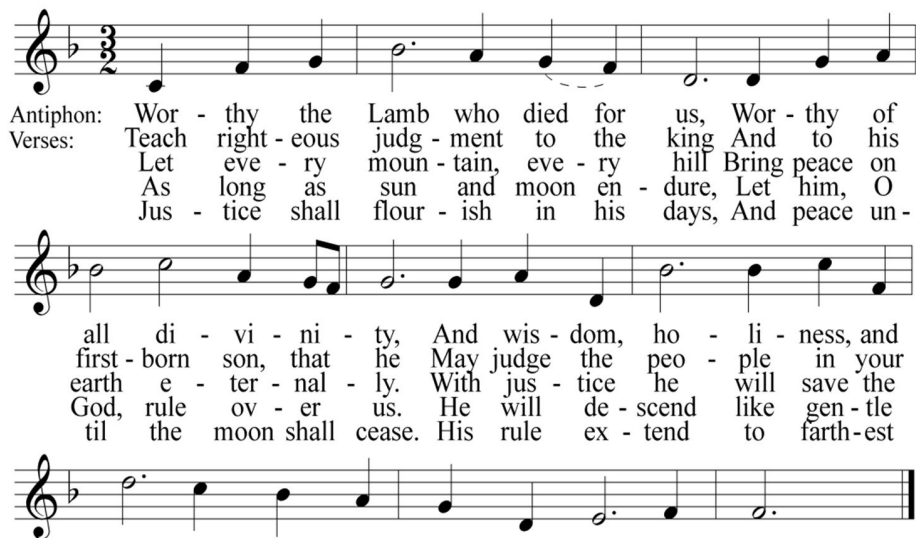

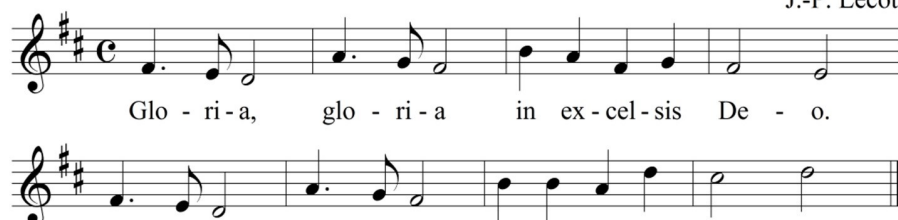

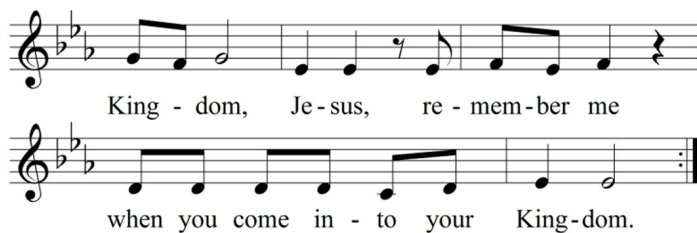

These documents are requested at registration:

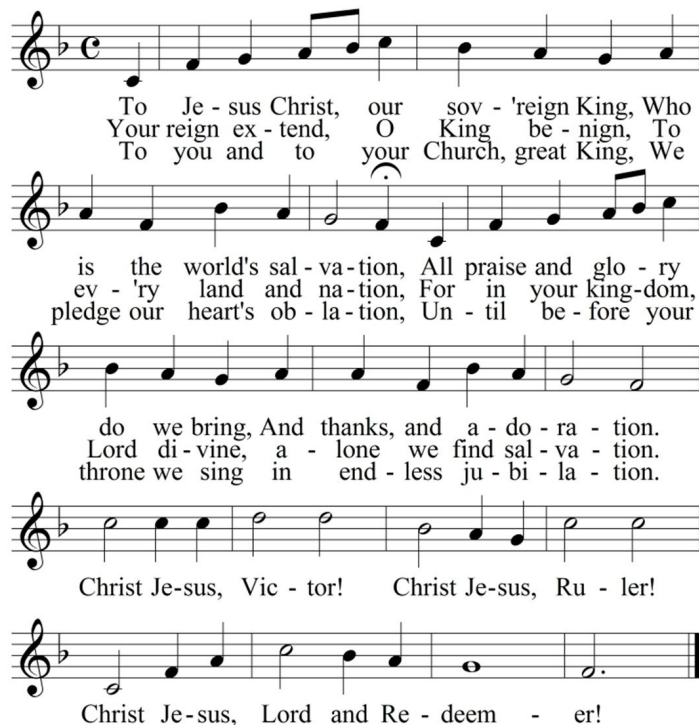
Please bring a copy of Child's Birth Certificate with \$100 payment by Cash or Check (\$50 for class only).
