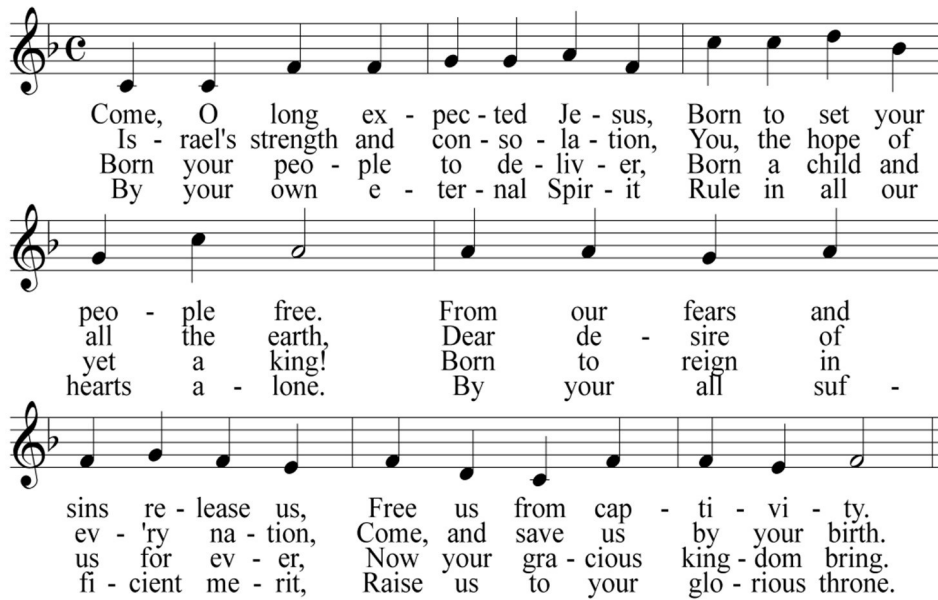


Communion for the First Sunday of Advent, "Dominus dabit." Copyright (c) 2007 Christoph Tietze.

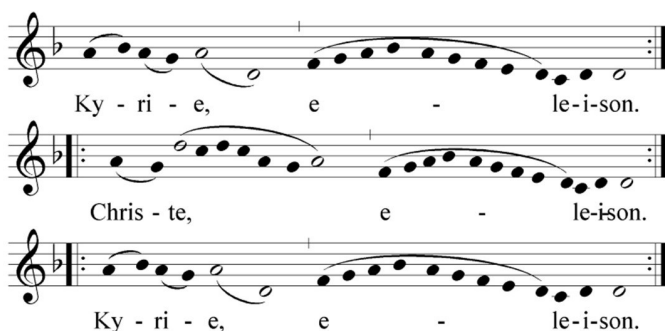

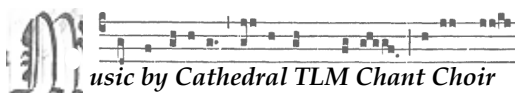
