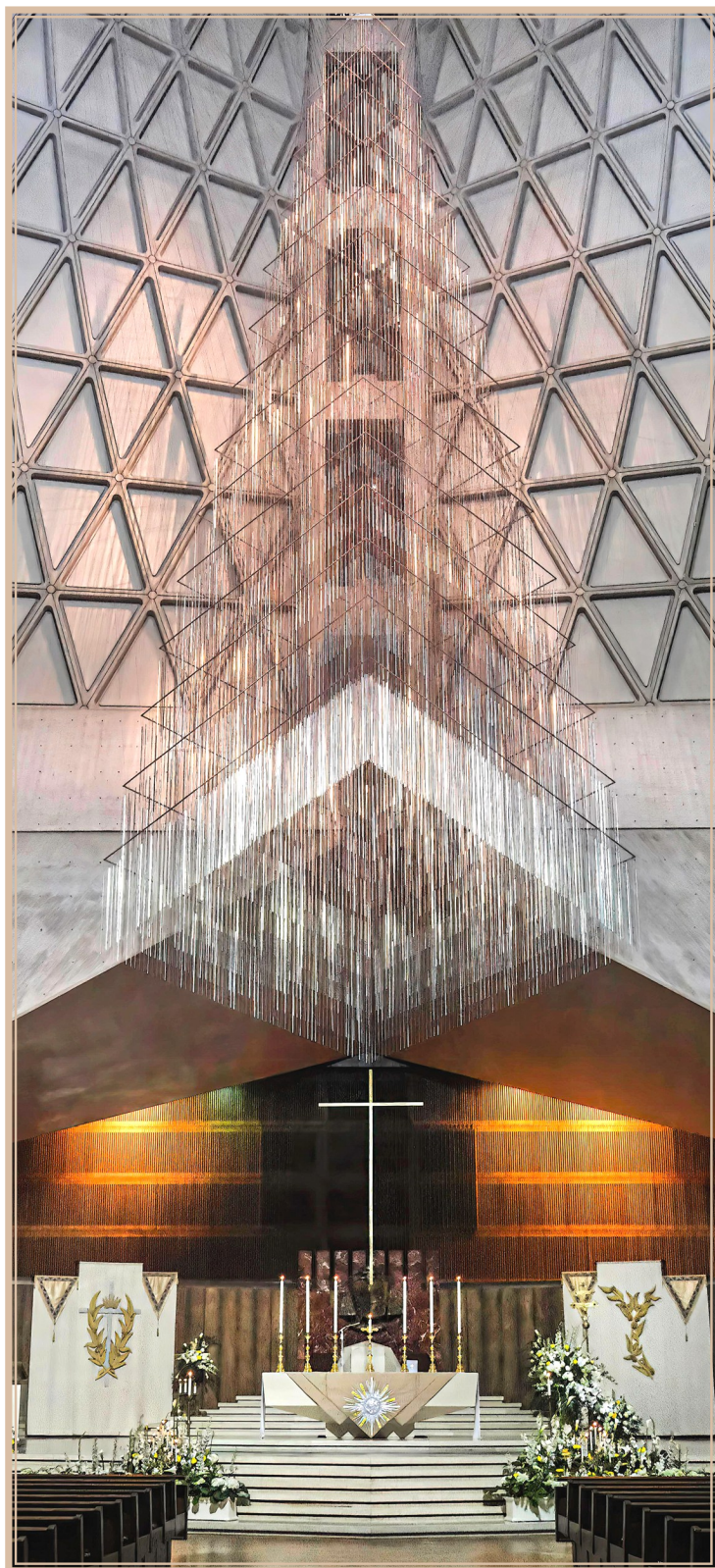

TURNING TOGETHER TOWARD THE LORD: A REFLECTION ON 'AD ORIENTUM' LITURGY

You will notice here at St. Mary's Cathedral that, during the Liturgy of the Eucharist, the priest faces in the same direction as the people – "ad orientem" – that is, facing east (symbolically, even if not literally) with the people. This ancient practice, consistently observed by the Church until recent times and still fully permitted by the Church's liturgical norms, carries deep spiritual significance.

East is the origin of light: the rising sun has always been a reminder to Christians that Christ is the light of the world, who dispels the darkness of sin and death by his Resurrection from the grave. East also represents paradise, as, at the creation, God placed the garden in the east (Gen 2:8). While Mass with the priest facing the people began about sixty years ago to help foster greater active participation of the assembly, the more ancient posture *ad orientem*, which in no way diminishes the people's role of active participation, symbolically expresses that the Mass is not a closed circle or a conversation between priest and people, but an act of worship directed to God in which the priest leads the people in a common pilgrimage toward our heavenly homeland to meet the Lord who is to come.

Far from turning his back on the people, the priest is leading them, as a shepherd at the head of the flock, toward the heavenly liturgy. Let us, then, welcome this sacred posture that beautifully reflects the words we sing at every Mass as one Mystical Body facing Jesus Christ, the Head, in hope and adoration: "Lift up your hearts. We lift them up to the Lord."
